

Poker Run – How It Works

Participants will purchase a blank “hand” at the registration desk or check-in if pre-registered. They will carry their hand to each of 5 check-points. A card will be drawn at each check-point and marked on the hand. Return completed hand to the Poker Run booth. You may buy up to 2 additional cards at the end of the run, if desired. Best poker hand wins.

Rules:

Participants must:

- Be 18 years old.
- Sign Release and Ride Form
- Start Run between 9:00 and 11:00 am
- Present one hand at a time at each check-point before drawing one card for that hand.
- No duplicate cards (draw again).
- Return “hand” by 3:00 pm
- Play as many hands as desired.
- Choose one card per hand at each of 5 check-points (Check-in desk is check-point #1.)
- Purchase up to 2 additional cards at end of run (\$10 each)

Please remember this is not a race!
Participants should observe all applicable traffic regulations.

Mountain Loop Experience II is an annual event held in Granite Falls, WA. The Poker Run is one of the many events held as part of this celebration of the re-opening of the Mountain Loop Highway. The Poker Run starts and ends at The Chamber of Commerce Booth, located at “IGAly’s” (the field between IGA and Alfy’s) on N. Granite Avenue in Granite Falls,

You may preregister for the Poker Run by completing the registration form online at the web address below. Cost is \$10 per “hand” for preregistration, and \$15 per “hand” on event day. Purchase as many hands as you like.

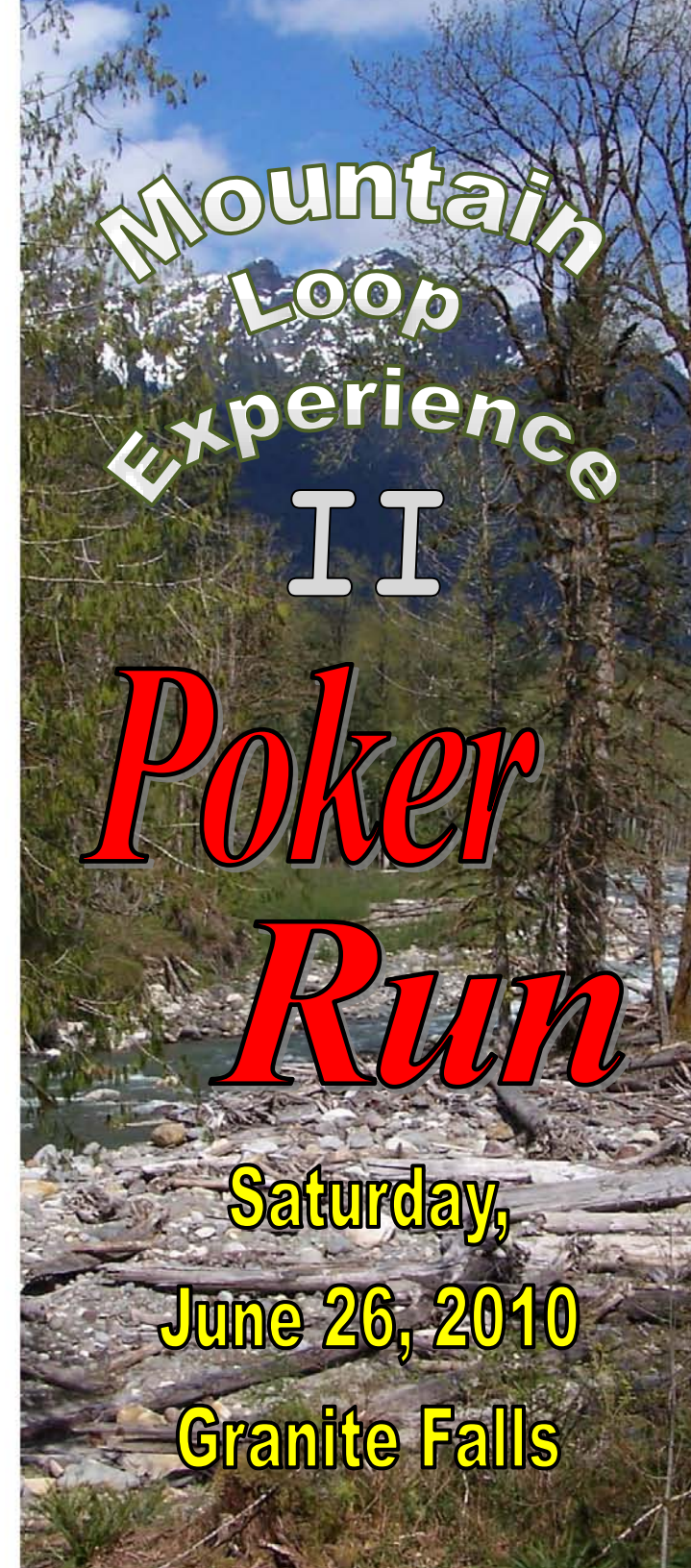
The map on the reverse shows the course for the Poker Run with the Check Points (the Chamber Booth is Check Point #1). The course is approximately 95 miles long, with about 14 miles of gravel. Please allow a minimum of 3-1/2 hours to complete the course. Participants may start between 9:00am and 11:00am and MUST return to the start point no later than 3:00pm or be disqualified.

Turn left at traffic signal onto Arlington Heights Road (80.8 miles from start).
Travel 1 mile, turn right onto Jordan Road.

Check Point #4 - Darrington IGA
Turn left onto Hwy 530 at the 4-way stop in Darrington (53.8 miles from start). IGA is ahead on your right. Park in the lot, Check Point is near the store entrance.



Check Point #3 - Big Four Picnic Area
Pull into the Big Four parking area on the right, 25.7 miles from the town center. Check Point is on your right at the covered picnic table.

Check Point #5
Riverside Community Center. A small 100-year-old school house on the left side of Jordan Road

Gravel for 13.9 miles

Check Point #1 - Registration Desk
The first check point is right at the registration point. Open from 9:00 am to 11:00 am. Distances are measured from 4-way stop (flashing light) in central Granite Falls.

Check Point #2 - Paca Pride Guest Ranch
Paca Pride will be on your left, 7.5 miles from the center of town.
